

SUBMISSION CHECKLIST

Authors can use this list to carry out a final check on their submission before sending it to the journal for review. Before beginning your submission be sure to review the Author Guidelines and ensure that the following items are present:

1. Cover letter

Author Declaration is a mandatory part of a submission, covering a number of logistic and ethical issues. Therefore, it is advised to provide and undersign a cover letter declaring that this manuscript or work is original, has not been published before and is not currently being considered for publication elsewhere. The authors in the cover letter can also take the opportunity to introduce their work to the editor by explaining why the manuscript will be of interest to the readership of Journal of Ceramic Processing Research.

2. Essential title page information

- Authors List:

Mention the name of all coauthors and clearly indicate the corresponding author(s) with contact details: E-mail address and full postal address who is willing to handle correspondence at all stages of refereeing and publication, also post-publication. All the authors' affiliation addresses (where the actual work was done) should be presented below the names. Indicate all affiliations with a lower-case superscript letter immediately after the author's name and in front of the appropriate address.

- Abstract

- Keywords

3. Main Text

- Introduction

- Experimental

- Results and Discussion

- Conclusion

- Acknowledgment

- Reference

- Figures (include relevant captions). Ensure all figure and table citations in the text match the files provided.

- Tabulation (including titles, description, footnotes)

Note: Figures and Tables can also appear at the first possible place after they are referenced in the text.

Further considerations

- Manuscript has been 'spell checked' and 'grammar checked'.
- All references mentioned in the Reference List are cited in the text, and vice versa.
- Permission has been obtained for use of copyrighted material from other sources (including the Internet).
- Only black/white figures that are recognizable by readers are accepted. Referee suggestions and contact details provided, based on journal requirements.
- All files are in the correct file format and of the appropriate resolution or size
